

RESOLUTION 98-11

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Township of Concord, Lake County, Ohio, is responsible for the maintenance of Township roads, and

WHEREAS, the Township performs regular maintenance and repair of roads; and

WHEREAS, many of the existing subdivisions within Concord Township have concrete roads that are breaking up and require extensive repair and revitalization; and

WHEREAS, the performance of these repairs to concrete roads is becoming extremely costly to the Township; and


WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Concord Township, Lake County, Ohio, has determined that in the best interest of the future of the Township and its residents that concrete streets be prohibited within the new subdivisions of Concord Township.


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that all new streets built in new subdivisions within Concord Township be constructed with concrete curbs only, and that all streets be constructed with a minimum of seven inches of asphalt layered over a prepared subbase material, and that all streets and curbing are to be built in accordance with the State of Ohio Department of Transportation's "Construction and Material Specifications Manual" and as reviewed and approved by the Lake County Engineer.


