Hoose Road and Andrea Road Bridge Replacement Projects

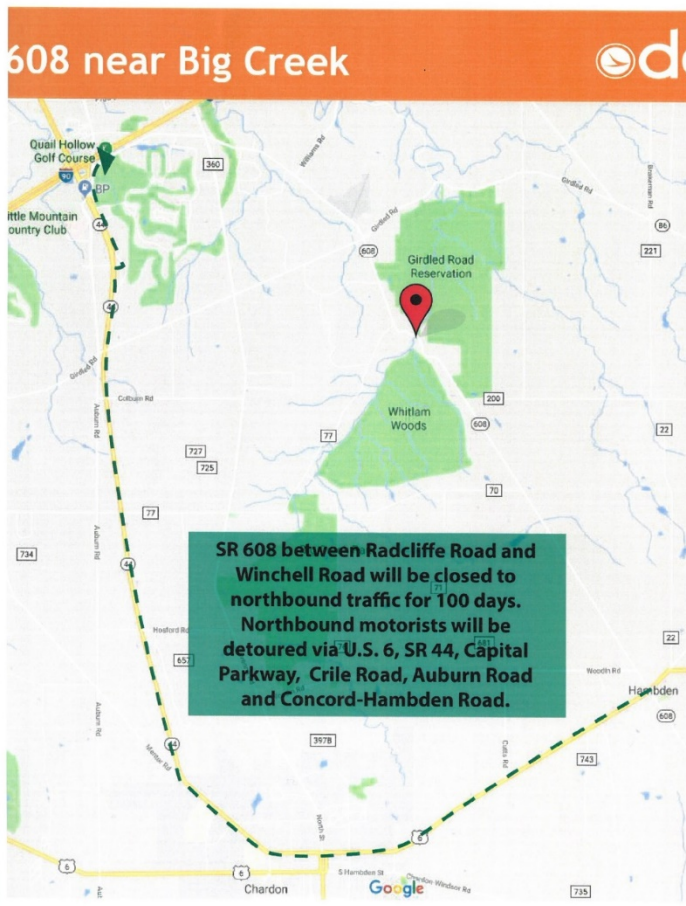
The Hoose Road and Andrea Road Bridge projects are scheduled to begin on Tuesday, May 29, 2018 and to be substantially complete with the bridges open to traffic on Wednesday, August 15, 2018.

The Hoose Road Bridge is approximately 0.10 miles east of King Memorial in the City of Mentor. The Andrea Road Bridge is located 0.30 miles north of Hoose Road in Concord Township. Both projects will require that the bridges be closed and that all traffic be detoured. The posted detours are as follows:

- Hoose Road – King Memorial to SR 84 to Button Road
- Andrea Road – Hoose Road to Mountain Park Drive

SR 608 Drainage Slope Stabilization Project (near Big Creek)



UPDATED 6/7/18: On Monday, June 11, 2018 (previously June 4), Concord-Hambden Road will close to northbound traffic between Radcliffe and Winchell Roads for 100 days as major slope repair work takes place by crews on behalf of ODOT.

During the closure, southbound Concord-Hambden Road will remain open between Winchell and Radcliffe Roads. **Northbound motorists will be detoured via U.S. Route 6 (GAR Highway), SR 44, Capital Parkway, Crile Road, Auburn Road and Concord-Hambden Road (see detour map).**

Tentative completion date is October 2018.
