WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 505.10(D) requires the Concord Township Board of Trustees to adopt a Resolution during each calendar year expressing its intent to dispose of surplus, unneeded, obsolete, or unfit personal property through the use of an internet auction; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Concord Township, Lake County, Ohio:

<u>Section 1</u>. That the Concord Township Board of Trustees hereby expresses its intent to dispose of surplus, unneeded, obsolete, or unfit personal property through the use of an internet auction during the calendar year 2017.

Section 2. That the personal property disposed of through the internet-based auction may include as specified in Ohio Revised Code Section 505.10(D), motor vehicles acquired for the use of Township officers and departments, road machinery, car parts, equipment, tools, and office equipment or supplies which are not needed, obsolete, or unfit for the public use for which it was acquired.

Section 3. That all property is offered for sale "as is, where is" with Concord Township making no warranty, guarantee, or representation of any kind expressed or implied, as to the condition of said items; and that any computers sold via internet-based auction shall have their hard drive either wiped utilizing U. S. Department of Defense standards or the hard drive will be removed; and the Buyer will received notification by email from the Concord Township auction and be required to make payment in full via U.S. currency, certified cashier's check, money or company check (with bank letter guaranteeing funds) within five (5) business days from the time and date of said notification; and the buyer will be responsible for removal of said items from the Concord Township facility within ten (10) days of receipt of said notification.

<u>Section 4</u>. That the number of days bidding for each auction, in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 505.10(D) will be at least fifteen (15) days, including Saturdays and Sundays, and holidays.

<u>Section 5</u>. That the Fiscal Officer shall publish in a newspaper of general circulation, notice of its intent to sell surplus, unneeded, obsolete, and unfit-for-use Township personal property by internet-based auction to be published once.

<u>Section</u> 6. That a similar notice shall be posted continuously throughout the calendar year in a conspicuous place in Concord Township Hall and in addition shall be posted continuously on the Concord Township website (www.concordtwp.com) with a link to GovDeals (http://www.govdeals.com), 5970 Carmichael Place, Montgomery, Alabama, 36117, phone (708) 714-2600, fax (334) 387-0519.

Section 7. That when property is to be sold by internet-based auction, the Concord Township Board of Trustees or its representatives reserve the right, at a later date, to establish a minimum price that will be accepted for specific items and may establish any other terms and conditions for the particular sale, including but not limited to requirements of pick-up or delivery, method of payment, and payment of sales tax in accordance with applicable laws.

Section 8. That such information shall be provided on the internet at the time of the auction and may be provided before that time upon request after the terms and conditions have been determined by the Board or its representatives.

<u>Section 9</u>. That the Board of Concord Township Trustees hereby authorizes the disposition of surplus, unneeded, obsolete, or unfit Township personal property via internet-based auction in calendar year 2017.

Section 10.
