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The Concord Township Board of Trustees met for a regular meeting May 17, 2017, 7:30 p.m., in Township Hall, located at 7229 Ravenna Road. Chairman Paul R. Malchesky called the meeting to order and led in the Pledge of Allegiance. Trustees present were Paul R. Malchesky, Caroline N. Luhta. Christopher A. Galloway is in Washington DC on Township business.

Mr. Malchesky – Storm water issues resolved. We are working with ODOT regarding SR 44 & 190 complaints.  
Mrs. Luhta – A couple of issues resolved.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

APRIL FINANCIAL STATEMENTS. Mrs. Luhta moved to approve the financial statements for April. Mr. Malchesky seconded. Vote 2 ayes.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

- A. RESOLUTION 2017-13 / RESOLUTION OPPOSING OHIO HOUSE BILL 178 & SENATE BILL 128'S FIRST ENERGY CORP.'S NUCLEAR BAILOUT. Mrs. Luhta moved to adopt the following resolution.

**RESOLUTION 2017-13**

**A RESOLUTION OPPOSING OHIO HOUSE BILL 178 AND SENATE BILL 128'S FIRST ENERGY CORP.'S NUCLEAR BAILOUT**

WHEREAS, Concord Township has established an opt-out electricity aggregation program for eligible electric consumers within the Township, joined the Northeast Ohio Public Energy Council ("NOPEC") and participates in NOPEC's opt-out electricity governmental aggregation program;

WHEREAS, governmental aggregation has been the "jewel" of Ohio electric deregulation, and has helped Concord Township's residents save money on their electric bills;

WHEREAS, opt-out governmental electricity aggregation has been widely recognized, in Ohio and nationally, as being successful in bringing benefits to residential and small business customers;

WHEREAS, at the end of 2016, the NOPEC communities of Northeast Ohio have saved collectively over \$275 Million on their constituents' residential and small business electric bills since 2001;

WHEREAS, the Ohio Legislature is considering bills that would provide subsidies for FirstEnergy's nuclear power plants in Ohio, to be paid for by rate increases to customers of FirstEnergy's Ohio distribution utilities, and which the residents of Concord Township would pay as customers;

WHEREAS, HB 178 and SB 128 provide for subsidies to be paid for by ratepayers, including residents in this Township which totals about \$300 Million per year for up to 16 years to subsidize FirstEnergy's uncompetitive, unregulated, nuclear plants; WHEREAS, House Bill 178 and Senate Bill 128 would cause residential customers to pay up to \$1,000 in subsidies to FirstEnergy for the nuclear plant bailout, and would also negatively impact Ohio's competitive energy market;

WHEREAS, a 2016 study conducted by Ohio State University and Cleveland State University concluded that Ohio electric customers have saved about \$15 Billion over the past five years on

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the generation portion of their electric bills and are projected to save an additional \$15 Billion on their electric bills over the next five years because of electric deregulation and the competitive markets for electric generation available in Ohio and on the regional electric grid;

WHEREAS, in 2001, the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio ("PUCO") granted FirstEnergy \$6.9 Billion in stranded costs to transition from regulation to deregulation for its electric generation plants, and all ratepayers paid such amounts from 2001 to 2010;

WHEREAS, in 2016, the FirstEnergy utilities were awarded an additional \$204 Million per year for up to six years by the PUCO, to be paid by the utility's customers, in the form of a distribution modernization rider (with no requirement to spend money on facilities or equipment) for up to six years, which was designed to bolster FirstEnergy's credit rating;

WHEREAS, many residents in Concord Township simply cannot afford an additional increase in their electric bills, particularly to bail out uneconomic FirstEnergy nuclear plants, the risks of which were to be borne by FirstEnergy, not ratepayers, when they were deregulated and received billions of dollars in payments from customers; and

WHEREAS, Concord Township strongly opposes subsidizing FirstEnergy's uncompetitive nuclear plants and supports a continuation of Ohio's successful competitive energy market.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF CONCORD TOWNSHIP THAT:

1. The Board of Trustees of Concord Township strongly and vigorously opposes House Bill 178 and Senate Bill 128 and urges the Ohio Legislature not to pass these bills; and
2. The Board of Trustees and Concord Township urges the Ohio Legislature to reject proposed subsidies and policies that erode the competitive electricity market that has provided benefits to Ohioans.

Mr. Malchesky seconded. Vote 2 ayes.

- B. FIRE DEPT. RESOLUTION 2017-14 / RESOLUTION DECLARING THE NECESSITY FOR A RENEWAL TAX LEVY TO BOARD OF ELECTIONS. Mrs. Luhta moved to adopt the following resolution.

**RESOLUTION 2017 - 14**

**A RESOLUTION BY THE CONCORD TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES,  
LAKE COUNTY, OHIO,  
DECLARING THE NECESSITY FOR A RENEWAL TAX LEVY  
IN EXCESS OF THE TEN-MILL LIMITATION**

WHEREAS, the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten-mill limitation will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of Concord Township, Lake County, Ohio,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Concord Township Board of Trustees, Lake County, Ohio, a majority of members concurring, that it is necessary to levy a renewal of 2.7 mills for the benefit of Concord Township, for the purpose of providing and maintaining fire apparatus, appliances, buildings or sites therefor, or sources of water supply and materials therefor, or the establishment and maintenance of lines of fire alarm telegraph, the payment of permanent, part-time, or volunteer firefighters or firefighting companies to operate the same, including the payment of the firefighters employer's contribution required under Section 742.34 of the Ohio Revised Code, or to purchase ambulance equipment, or to provide ambulance, paramedic, or emergency medical services operated by a fire department or firefighting company, at rate not exceeding 2.7 mills for each one dollar of valuation which amounts to 27 cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation for a period of five (5) years commencing with the tax year 2017, for collection commencing in 2018.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the renewal levy be submitted to the Electors of Concord Township at the general election to be held at the usual voting places within the Township on November 7, 2017.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the levy be placed upon the tax lists for tax years 2017 through 2021 in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.19(I) if a majority of the electors voting thereon vote in favor thereof.



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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the Fiscal Officer is hereby directed to certify a copy of the Resolution to the Board of Elections of Lake County, Ohio, not less than ninety (90) days before the election and notify the Board of Elections to cause notice of election on the question of levying the tax to be given as required by law.

A renewal of tax for the benefit of Concord Township, for the purpose of providing and maintaining fire apparatus, appliances, buildings or sites therefor, or sources of water supply and materials therefor, or the establishment and maintenance or lines of fire alarm telegraph, the payment of permanent, part-time, or volunteer firefighters or firefighting companies to operate the same, including the payment of the firefighters employer's contribution required under Section 742.34 of the Ohio Revised Code, or to purchase ambulance equipment, or to provide ambulance or emergency medical services operated by a fire department or firefighting company, at rate not exceeding 2.7 mills for each one dollar of valuation which amounts to 27 cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation for a period of five (5) years commencing with the tax year 2017, for collection commencing in 2018.

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


