The Concord Township Board of Trustees met for a Special Meeting on August 1, 2017, 5:00 p.m., at the Concord Community Center, located at 7671 Auburn Road. Chairman Paul R. Malchesky called the meeting to order. Trustees present were Caroline N. Luhta, Paul R. Malchesky, and Christopher A. Galloway.

The purpose of the meeting was to have an informal question and answer session to provide accurate information to residents about the zoning process and overlay district. There was no formal agenda.


Five sign in sheets were passed among the attendees, and three sheets were returned, so it was impossible to identify all of the speakers. Speakers were not recognized individually before each question. There were over 130 people in attendance.

Mr. Malchesky spoke in detail about the 2004 Comprehensive Plan and the 2015 update. Mr. Galloway answered questions about the process a Township would have to take to become a city and all of the Trustees answered that that is not a consideration. In addition, all of the Trustees answered questions about the Joint Economic Development Districts, Commercial Districts, Mixed Use Developments, and the traffic pattern changes at Auburn and State Route 44.
