WHEREAS, the State Capital Improvement Program ("SCIP") and the Local Transportation Improvement Program ("LTIP") both provide financial assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvements to public infrastructure, and

WHEREAS, Concord Township is planning to make capital improvements to Christian Avenue and Jason Avenue and its drainage system that is no longer functional thereby undermining and damaging the roadway surface, with such improvements to include necessary total reconstruction to the roadway, and

WHEREAS, the Township is pursuing funding assistance from the Ohio Public Works Commission ("OPWC") to complete these infrastructure improvements, and

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvements herein above described is considered to be a priority need for the community and is a qualified project under the OPWC programs.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Concord Township Board of Trustees, Lake County, Ohio that:

<u>Section 1</u>. Paul R. Malchesky, as Chairman of the Board of Trustees, or his duly authorized representative, is hereby authorized to prepare and submit an application to the Ohio Public Works Commission for funds necessary to complete the Christian Avenue and Jason Avenue infrastructure improvements described herein.

<u>Section 2</u>. Paul R. Malchesky, or his duly authorized representative, is further authorized to execute any and all additional documentation necessary to properly formalize and secure the implementation of such infrastructure improvement funding.

<u>Section 3</u>. The Board of Trustees of Concord Township hereby requests the State of Ohio to consider and approve its application for Ohio Public Works Commission funding.

<u>Section 4</u>. It is found and determined that all formal actions of the Board of Trustees of Concord Township concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of the Board of Trustees of Concord Township and that all deliberations of this Board that resulted in those formal actions were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
