

# 2019 CONSTRUCTION UPDATES

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## Carter Road Project

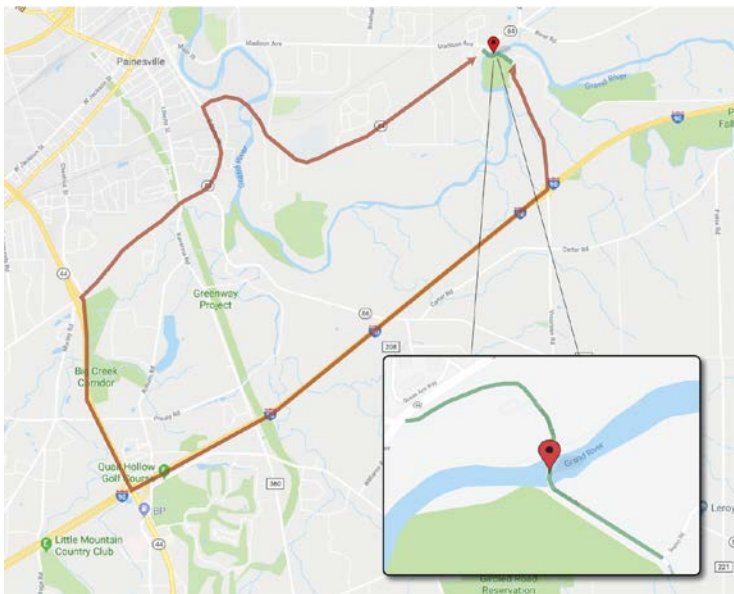
Beginning at 8:00 am on Monday, June 10, 2019, Carter Road in Concord Township will be closed to all traffic. The closure will be approximately 0.15 miles east of SR 86. The closure is necessary to repair a stone arch culvert under the road. The road is scheduled to re-open to traffic on Friday, August 9, 2019.

Motorists are reminded to abide by the closure and not move barricades. The posted detour will be Vrooman Road to SR 86. Contact the Lake County Engineers Office at (440) 350-2770 for more information or questions.

## Christian Avenue & Jason Avenue Reconstruction

On May 20, 2019, Tri Mor Corporation will begin the reconstruction project on Christian Avenue and Jason Avenue. The work will consist of the removal and replacement of the existing concrete pavement on these streets. During the majority of the work, traffic shall be maintained in a one-way pattern. Traffic will be directed to **enter only at Jason Avenue and exit only at Christian Avenue**. Please drive *slowly* through construction zones. ## Vrooman Road Bridge Project



Through fall 2020, the intersection of **Seeley Rd. and Vrooman Rd. will be closed** to accommodate the construction work zone. Seeley Rd. will remain accessible via Paine Rd., maintaining access to Indian Point Park. Access will be maintained for emergency vehicles. The entire project will construct a new Vrooman Rd. bridge over the Grand River on a new alignment, along with the resurfacing of the existing Vrooman Rd. between the new structure and I-90. Tentative completion date: October 2020.

**May 21, 2019 News Release from Lake County Engineer's Office:** Beginning Thursday, May 23, 2019, Great Lakes Construction will be receiving delivery of steel girders needed for the construction of the Vrooman Road Bridge project. A start time has not been provided. The deliveries, which will initially be from the south side

off of I-90, will continue for approximately the next two months. The girders are approximately 100' in length. Drivers are asked to use caution, be patient and expect delays when they are driving near the delivery trucks.
