CHAIRMAN PETERSON: Good morning. I'd like to call to order the Concord Township Zoning Commission meeting for Tuesday, July 16, 2019. This is a special meeting, as our normal July meeting was canceled. We have an item that's now been added to the agenda, so therefore we're calling this meeting this morning.

A short agenda. The first item on the agenda is the main reason we're here today. And I am going to read this for the record but it's to schedule a public hearing for Zoning Amendment Application Number 0719-1 by the Auburn Career Center, requesting a Zoning Map amendment on a portion of land currently known as Permanent Parcel Number 08A-021-0-00-051-0, whose address is 8159 Auburn, as further described in Exhibit A and being about .947 acres of land, from the current zoning district of Gateway Business to the R-1 Residential District.

So what we're doing this morning is scheduling a public hearing at our August meeting for that request. Any discussion?

MR. REPPERT: Why? Is there something wrong with what they're planning on doing in the Gateway as opposed to R-1?

CHAIRMAN PETERSON: I guess it's because it's becoming a training facility, correct, which --

MS. FREEMAN: So we can further discuss this during the public hearing but based on, you know, the application they submitted, it looks like the project that they would like to do there is not permitted under the Gateway Business.

MR. REPPERT: That's all I wanted to know.

MS. FREEMAN: And they're trying to rezone it to a 1 district where it would be a permitted use. 2 CHAIRMAN PETERSON: So the land will be used as a 3 training facility as part of the school and, therefore, it 4 5 needs to go into the Residential District. So that will be scheduled at our meeting on 6 7 August 6th, the public hearing for that. 8 MS. FREEMAN: Mr. Chairman, we need someone to make a motion and second. 9 10 CHAIRMAN PETERSON: Yeah. MR. LINGENFELTER: Mr. Chairman, I make a motion 11 that we accept the zoning app, Zoning Amendment Application 12 13 Number 0719-1 by Auburn Career Center to be scheduled for the August 6th normally scheduled Zoning Commission meeting. 14 15 CHAIRMAN PETERSON: Do we have a second for that? MR. REPPERT: Second. 16 17 MR. McINTOSH: Second. MR. REPPERT: You've got two seconds. 18 19 CHAIRMAN PETERSON: Two seconds, okay. All in favor? Any opposed? None. 20 21 (Four aye votes, no nay votes.) 22 CHAIRMAN PETERSON: Okay. That will be scheduled 23 for our August 6th meeting. 24 The next item on the agenda this morning is the approval of the meeting, meeting minutes from June 4, 2019. 25 26 was not at that meeting, so I am going to abstain on that, but 27 do I have a motion to approve those minutes as written? 28 MR. REPPERT: I will make a motion that we approve the June 4, 2019, meeting minutes as written. 29 30 MR. McINTOSH: Second.

CHAIRMAN PETERSON: Okay. I have a motion and a 1 second. All in favor say "aye." 2 (Two aye votes, no nay votes, two abstentions.) 3 CHAIRMAN PETERSON: Very good. The minutes are 5 approved. Correspondence report by the various Zoning 6 7 Commission members that are here this morning. Morgan, 8 anything? 9 MR. McINTOSH: I've had a lot of correspondence in the township with residents about a lot of different things, 10 not many zoning matters, mostly fire station and some things 11 happening in the corridor. 12 13 CHAIRMAN PETERSON: Hiram, anything? MR. REPPERT: Nothing. 14 CHAIRMAN PETERSON: Andy? 15 MR. LINGENFELTER: Nothing, although I would like to 16 17 make a note that the Zoning Commission members present, based on the meeting minutes of June 4th, we don't have a quorum 18 19 here to approve those minutes. So we only have one person, well, two people out of the -- two people sitting on the 20 21 Zoning Commission right now that --22 CHAIRMAN PETERSON: Oh, you weren't here? MR. LINGENFELTER: No. That's why I didn't vote. 23 24 So we only have two people here, so I would say we should 25 table this until the next meeting. 26 CHAIRMAN PETERSON: That's a good point. 27 MS. FREEMAN: Yes. 28 MR. LINGENFELTER: And bring this up for a motion and then accept the meeting minutes when we have the proper 29

members here to go ahead and approve that.

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CHAIRMAN PETERSON: Very good point, Andy. We will reschedule then the approval of the June 4th meeting minutes for our August 6th meeting when we do have a proper quorum.

Okay. As far as correspondence on myself, like Morgan, I've had a lot of inquiries about what's going on with the fire station but nothing really related to zoning.

Item 4 on the agenda, Audience Participation, it appears we have no audience participation this morning, so we will move on. So Item 5 then is just simply to schedule our next Zoning Commission meeting, which will be on August 6th, 2019, at the usual time, 7:00 p.m.

Any other discussion this morning? If there is no other discussion, we will adjourn the meeting.
