Minutes of Concord Township Board of Trustees Special Meeting

Held on June 16, 2021

The Concord Township Board of Trustees met with Chardon Township Trustees in a Special Joint Meeting on June 16, at 5:30 p.m., in the Conference Room of Town Hall, located at 7229 Ravenna Road. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss road improvements on shared roads and to sign the 2021 Road Maintenance Agreement. Both Townships are to investigate, budget, and coordinate repairs for Colburn Road for 2021. Concord Township Administrator, Andy Rose, will prepare a joint letter addressing Colburn Road maintenance issues to the Geauga County Engineer's Office related to the road repairs that occurred in 2014.

The following 2021 Road Maintenance Agreement between the two entities was signed:

CHARDON TOWNSHIP and CONCORD TOWNSHIP 2021 ROAD MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT

The goal of this agreement is to establish a framework that outlines the responsibilities of each township as it relates to our jointly-owned roads: Colburn and Little Mountain. This agreement will also provide a path for future Boards and is designed to serve our residents.

COLBURN ROAD

- 1. For patching, filling potholes, general repairs and snow plowing: each township will perform these functions for the section of road as outlined below:

Ravenna Road to TimberlaneChardon Township
 Timberlane to Auburn.....Concord Township

- 2. For ditching and mowing of Colburn Road, the responsibilities will be split as follows:

South side.....Chardon Township
 North side.....Concord Township


LITTLE MOUNTAIN ROAD

- 1. Patching, filling potholes and general repairs will be performed by Chardon Township.
- 2. Snow plowing will be performed by Concord Township.
- 3. For ditching and mowing, the responsibilities will be split as follows:

South side.....Chardon Township
 North side.....Concord Township
