CHAIRMAN McINTOSH: Good evening. I would like to call to order Concord Township Board of Trustees. We have a public hearing set at 7:15 and the public hearing is for a text amendment to Section 13.33(E), Outside Dining, and the hearing is to discuss deleting existing requirement for maximum outside seating capacity.

With that, Mrs. Freeman, would you like to take us through the change?

MS. FREEMAN: Sure. Thank you, Mr. Chairman. A member of the Zoning Commission was contacted by one of our resident businesses in Concord several months ago in regards to our outside dining conditional use permit requirements, and one of them had a maximum capacity for the outside seating area that was relative to the number of seats inside the restaurant, and had requested that the Zoning Commission take a look at that and see if that was something that we wanted to keep in or eliminate.

So staff went back and looked at the recently approved outdoor dining areas and variances were approved well over 25 percent for all of them that had been approved since 2016. So based on that information and some of the other controls that we already have related to outside dining -- because it is a conditionally permitted use which does require a special permit -- the board decided that we didn't need to limit that seating capacity relative to the indoor seating capacity.

So what they have suggested, and that the Planning Commission has also recommended approval of and the Zoning Commission for you tonight, is that we strike out just that

one sentence that limits the outside seating capacity to no more than 25 percent of the indoor seating capacity. So this would be applicable, if it became effective, with any new outdoor dining area that might come in front of the township or any existing outdoor dining area that might be looking at expanding. So I don't know if there is any other questions. I would be happy to answer them. MS. LUCCI: No. MR. DONDORFER: I don't have any. CHAIRMAN McINTOSH: Okay. Being as it is a public hearing, I will open it up to public question or comment and we will start with -- I know we have one virtual -- we will start with those that are here, present in Town Hall. If anybody would like to speak regarding this zoning text amendment, please come forward, state your name and address for the record. (No response.) Seeing none, I will ask if there is any Okay. comment or question from the virtual audience. (No response.)

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Okay. Hearing none, I will then accept a motion to close the public hearing if there is no further discussion from the Board.

MS. LUCCI: Mr. Chairman, I move that we close the public hearing.

MR. DONDORFER: I will second.
