1795 - Native Americans relinquish most of Ohio for settlement

1795 - Connecticut Land Company purchases 3 million acres of Western Reserve; some of it to become N.E. Ohio

1796 - Moses Cleaveland survey party passes through future Concord Township lands

1849 - Stickney-Huntoon Cemetery - Rt. 86 & Gray

1849 - Lake & Trumbull Plank Road Company Formed

1850 - Stocking House opened

1857 - Little Mountain Eagle Hotel built

1858 - Huntoon School - Rt. 608 & Girdled Road

1858 - Judd's Corner School opens - Williams Road & Warren



### 1797

1797 - Girdled Road construction contract signed (\$2,600)

1802 - First log cabin built in present day Concord Twp.

1802 - Thomas Jordan becomes first permanent settler

1803 - Jordan Family settles in present day Concord Twp.

1808 - David French starts Gristmill at Kellogg Creek

1810 - Ravenna Road construction authorized (\$50)

1812 - First Schoolhouse established - Judd's Corners

### 1818

1818 - Williams Tavern, stage coach stop

1820 - Pease Turning Mill - Cascade Hollow



### 1870

1870 - Original Town Hall constructed

1874 - Concord Twp. Methodist Church built (1940)

1880 - Pinecrest Hotel opened - Little Mountain Road

1890 - B&O Railroad assumes control of Concord Twp. freight line right-of-way off Ravenna Rd. (5.1mil)

1900 - Prouty Road School opens - off South Meadow

### 1822

**1822 - Concord Township Established**

1822 - Little Mountain Schoolhouse built

1822 - Maple Point Schoolhouse constructed

1824 - First Post Office, Town Hall grounds - Zenas Wilson, Postmaster

1825 - One room Schoolhouse established - Wilson's Corners

1825 - Incorporate Iron Furnace Company formed

1831 - Little Mountain House Hotel opens



### 1925

1925 - New Concord Elementary School ends one room era of schools

1931 - First Community Day held

### 1944

1944 - Concord Twp. School System merges with Riverside Schools

1948 - Concord Volunteer Fire Department begins



### 1833

1833 - Concord Twp. Cemetery

1838 - Mentor Avenue School opens near Nye Road



### 1838

1838 - Eber Howe moves to Liberty Hollow/UGRR station

1838 - House & Rogers Mill founded - near Fay Road



### 1954

1954 - Concord Airpark opened

1959 - Helen Hazen Wyman Park dedicated, first LMP park

1960s - Schoolhouse #1 serves as Field Office for I-90 construction

1961 - T.R. Evans Research Facility opens (Diamond Shamrock Co.)

1961 - Concord Township Garden Club established

1964 - Current Quail Hollow site opened

1965 - Auburn Career Center established

1966 - Fire Department Stations 1 & 2 open

1971 - Town Hall remodeled

1976 - Concord Twp. Elementary School closed

1989 - Old Stone Schoolhouse becomes business office

2001 - Township purchases Old Stone Schoolhouse property

2004 - Old Stone Schoolhouse renovated as a township history center

2006 - Old Stone Schoolhouse opened as township historical site

2022 - Concord Township Bicentennial Celebration
