RE: Brightwood Lake Dam Removal and Kellogg Creek Restoration Update

Dear Property Owner:

On behalf of the Lake County Commissioners and Concord Township Trustees, Civil & Environmental Consultants (CEC) is providing this update on the Brightwood Lake Dam Removal/Kellogg Creek Restoration project:

- RiverReach Construction recently began mobilizing heavy equipment to the work site.
- Construction is expected to begin the week of 7/18/2022.
- The majority of construction should be completed in 12 weeks (end of October).
- Construction work hours will typically be Monday through Thursday, from 7:00am to 6:00pm. On occasion, Fridays and Saturdays may be worked.
- Construction vehicles will use the Prouty Rd entrance to the work site. On occasion, construction vehicles may enter from the Township-owned property located at the west end of Barchester Dr.
- Construction will begin with the removal of the dam, followed by the excavation of the new floodplain within the former lakebed, and restoration of Kellogg Creek.
- Plantings will occur in late fall 2022 and spring of 2023.

#### **SAFETY**

- DO NOT ENTER THE CONSTRUCTION SITE. The orange fence will soon be relocated to the Environmental Covenant limits. Within the construction site, crews will be removing the hard crust and performing earthwork with heavy equipment, exposing the soft sediment below. The soft sediment is a hazard, especially for kids and pets. For your safety, do not walk past the orange fence onto the construction site at any time. If the need arises, please contact:
