Creamy Tomato & Spinach Pasta

Ingredients:

- 2 cups uncooked penne pasta
- 3 TBS olive oil
- 1 small onion
- 2 cloves garlic
- 1 can of diced tomatoes
- 2 TBS tomato paste
- 3-4 TBS plain Greek yogurt or cream cheese
- 1 BIG handful of fresh spinach
- 1/4 cup of grated parmesan cheese
- 1 tsp died oregano
- 1 tsp dried bail
- 1 pinch pf red pepper flakes
- 1/2 tsp salt
- 1/2 tsp pepper



Instructions:

- 1) Fill a large pot with water and bring to a boil.
- 2) While water is heating, dice the onion and grate or chop garlic. Add pasta to the boiling water and cook for 5-7 minutes or until al dente, drain noodles. DO NOT OVERCOOK
- 3) Heat oil in a large pot over medium heat, add onion and garlic, cook for 5 minutes or until translucent, stirring as needed.
- 4) Add the can of tomatoes, fresh spinach, and spices stirring after each item is added. Then add the tomato paste and Greek yogurt. Continue to stir until both are mized well into the sauce. Add parmesan cheese.
- 5) Lower heat to a simmer and add the cooked pasta.
- 6) Stir occasionally for 1 minute, taste and adjust with salt and pepper as needed.
- 7) ENJOY!
