The Citizens Advisory Committee recommends a 5-year 3.9 mil Fire Levy to address critical funding needs for fire and emergency medical services (EMS) in Concord Township. This levy aims to support essential personnel costs, equipment upgrades, and operational expenses, ensuring the community receives high-quality fire protection and EMS. The proposed levy will also free up existing safety levy funds to restore 24/7 police patrols with two deputies. Acknowledging economic challenges, the committee emphasizes the necessity of this levy to maintain service standards and enhance safety. Community engagement and transparent communication are prioritized to gain resident support for this crucial initiative.
